Do's and Don'ts

Greet them

- Lovingly greet them, saying hello and asking if there is anything we can help with? Do you need help? How can I help you?

Invite

- Invite and encourage them to sit and attend church service - connect with the Greeters or Hosts team for seating.

Offer to Provide Water

- If they would like water, we can leave them with someone in the lobby while we run to DTC to get them some water, or ask someone to grab water for you.
- We cannot provide food or bring them to DTC.

Pray

- Offer to pray for them. Escort them to the side or connect them with someone from the Prayer team if available. Pray with your eyes open if praying alone.

Provide resources

- Resource Card Pamphlet referral - behind the Small Groups Corner banner. Includes information about the Sharing Center up the road in Longwood.
- Encourage them to fill out our Help Form at <https://journeyorl.com/help/>.
- If available, connect them with someone available from Outreach (an Outreach dream teamer may be on standby to help or may be at the small groups corner)

Public Safety

- Ensure the Public Safety team knows and is aware of the person while still being kind, respectful, loving, and gracious.
